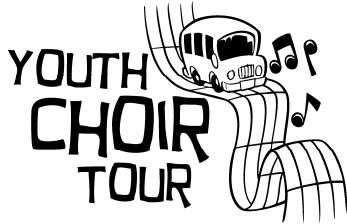

Please continue to collect your "Pop Tabs" for the Young Christian Singers.

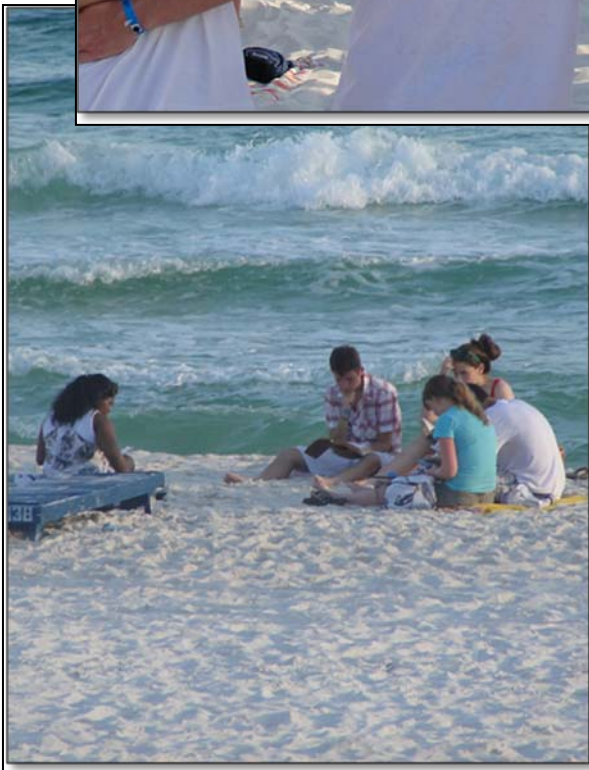
They are collecting them to donate to the Ronald McDonald House in Topeka when they are on their Mini Choir Tour. They will collect them until July 15th.
